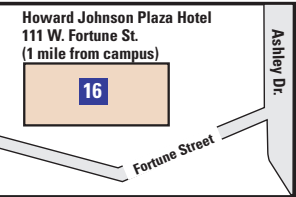

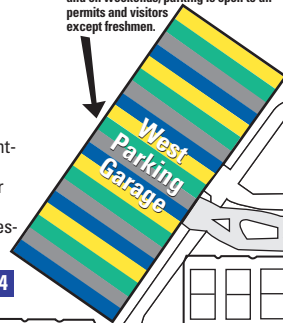
## CAMPUS PARKING KEY
